

FerrouSouth New Stretcher Leveler by Butech Bliss

FerrouSouth has completed the purchase of a new stretcher leveler from Butech Bliss. The line, which will be capable of stretching material up to ½" x 96" wide, will be operational in the spring of 2012.

The new stretcher leveler will be the biggest, most powerful stretcher leveler in North America. Designed to produce over 4 million pounds of stretching force, the line will eliminate internal stress from even ultra-high strength, high yield material and produce laser flat sheets.

FerrouSouth will install the stretcher leveler in-line with a Herr Voss ½" x 96", eleven roll precision leveler to elevate the processing range and performance of the stretcher. The combination of one of the most powerful Herr Voss leveling lines in the country with the most powerful stretcher line will allow FerrouSouth to offer an unprecedented capability to the Southern market.

The new stretcher will expand the toll processing capabilities that FerrouSouth provides to the ever growing base of steel producers, service centers, fabricators and OEMs in the South. FerrouSouth currently offers:

- Precision slitting from .054"-.625" x 72"
- Leveling from .060"-.565" x 96"
- UM plate from .125"-.565" x 4"-29"

The FerrouSouth facility is in the heart of the Southern steel and manufacturing industry. Located in Iuka Mississippi at the intersection of the Tennessee River and Tombigbee Waterway, FerrouSouth has a deep water port with barge access to provide economical water transportation. Direct rail access, major highway access and company owned trucking allows FerrouSouth to offer many shipping options.
